They combine a Full-Time job with study and are suitable for new and existing employees. Depending on previous qualifications and experience, they can be completed by anyone who is age 18 or over.

At our College we offer Degree Apprenticeships ranging from Higher National Certificates and Diplomas through to Foundation Degrees and full Bachelor's Degrees all validated by our partners such as Bournemouth University.

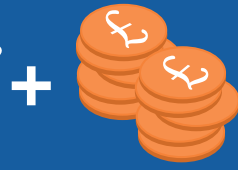
How they work?

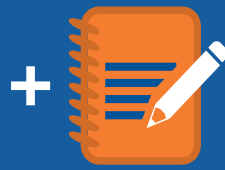
WORK

Apprentices can either be a new member of staff, or an existing employee, but they need to have a contract of employment.



PAY

Whilst as the employer you are allowed to determine the annual salary, Degree apprentices are entitled to at least the national minimum wage for their age.



STUDY

Degree Apprenticeships can be studied through day release or block release schemes, and/or independent study, and can vary in length depending on the course.



QUALIFICATION

As well as on-the-job learning, apprentices work towards their Degree, which is validated by our partner university.

A solution to fill your skills gaps

Studied over several years, Degree Apprenticeships provide an opportunity for apprentices to become an integral part of your workforce.

They are a cost-effective way to develop skills, fill skills gaps and grow your business. They are designed and delivered around your business needs and help you develop the specialist skills necessary to keep pace with the latest technology and working practices in your sector.

Paying for Degree Apprenticeships

There is no one set cost for Degree Apprenticeships, but they are co-funded by the Government. This means that depending on your business, the Government will pay a contribution towards training, or funds can be accessed from your levy account.

- ▶ **Small company less than 50 employees**
Government will contribute 90%, employer 10%, paid directly to The College
- ▶ **Large company over 50 employees (PAYE less than £3Mpa)**
Government will contribute 90%, employer 10%, paid directly to The College
- ▶ **Levy payer (PAYE over £3M)**
Money taken through HMRC and put into the Digital Apprenticeship Service (DAS)
